

#### Warning! - Email threats - to all businesses

Remember to be vigilant when going through your email! The Controller at a New River Computing client recently received an email from the organization's President. The email included a request for information about how to do a same day domestic bank transfer to a client, and expressed urgency.

But it wasn't actually from the President. The sending address was "President's Name First. Last@mail.com". In this case, the thief set up a new customized email account to send from, to make it look more like the President, and directly emailed the Controller by name. The information was probably gathered from LinkedIn or public websites.

Remember: If you receive an email for a request that doesn't make sense, check with the sender in person. Call them, email them at a known good (and different) address, or walk into their office.
